What We Do

The inspection and subsequent report is provided on an “area by area” basis.

Evaluate current spill response capability

- Identify and quantify the substances stored in the area
- Check spill kits for suitability with substances stored.
- Identify absorbent capacity of current spill response kits meets the requirement.
- Identify signage and location of spill response equipment to ensure accessibility.

Evaluate current chemical spill containment and storage devices

- Inspect safety cabinets for compliance to the relevant standard.
- Assess usage of safety cabinets to ensure they are being used as required by the relevant standard.
- Inspect the condition & suitability of bunding and secondary containment equipment.

Evaluate emergency shower and eyewash equipment

- General visual inspection of safety shower and eyewash equipment location & signage

Assess spill exit points including drainage systems

What You Get

Spill Station will issue a report capturing each area inspected. The report will contain observations of each aspect including reference photographs.

The report will identify areas of exposure and non-compliance in each of the assessed areas provide specific improvement recommendations for each area.
